Northern Lebanon High School will be running special activity buses for students to return home after school. Students involved in tutoring, athletics, detention hall, or needing transportation home from their classes held at the Lebanon County Career and Technology Center may utilize the activity buses throughout the school year.

The three activity buses will depart the MIDDLE SCHOOL ENTRANCE at 3:30 p.m. and HIGH SCHOOL GYM ENTRANCE at 5:30 p.m. Each bus will deliver student riders to selected areas in the Northern Lebanon School District according to the schedule outlined below. It is the parent and student's responsibility to provide transportation from the drop-off point to their home.

We hope this transportation service will be a benefit to our secondary students who are involved in the many after-school programs provided at Northern Lebanon High School.
