Members attended sessions and workshops and competed in CDEs and LDEs. Members were able to meet new people and learn real-life skills.

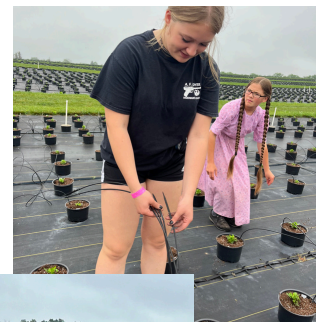
